INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

It is suggested to lay tiles with a joint of minimum 2 mm. ■ Use high quality adhesive and grout from a manufacturer such as Mapei, following manufacturer's recommendations and depending on site conditions. ■ As soon as the joints have fully set, it is advisable to proceed to the initial post-construction cleaning as described by the manufacturer. ■ Clean with a neutral detergent when needed. ■ When installing, mix the content of several boxes to ensure even distribution of the tile shading.

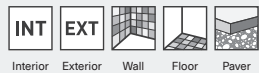

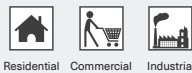

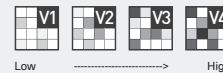
