INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

It is suggested to lay tiles with a joint of 2-3 mm. • Use high quality adhesive and grout from a manufacturer such as Mapei, following manufacturer's recommendations and depending on site conditions. Black grout (containing carbon or graphite) must not be used with polished glazed porcelain tiles because the pigments could stain the tile surface. • Clean with a neutral detergent when needed. • When installing, mix the content of several boxes to ensure even distribution of the tile shading.

■ It is recommended to seal the material once it has been installed and it has been properly cleaned.


